Paint Disclosure – Paint the Street 2018

No paint is completely nontoxic.

Paint the Street uses Streetbond 150, a paint marketed as non-toxic, low VOC, environmentally friendly, and water-based.

Streetbond 150 is a mix of 3 separate components, part A, part B, and a colorant.

Streetbond 150 is usually spray-applied, but we are applying by brush and roller.

While the paint is water based, it many components, including silica and a small percentage of petroleum distillates. Each colorant has different components. The Materials and Data Safety Sheets(MSDS) state some of these components may cause skin irritation, allergic reactions, and/or cancer.
